WILD ANIMALS

Did you know that there are three classes of wild animals? Some are carnivores, herbivores and others omnivores. Let's look at a few of them.

The largest land mammal is an elephant . Elephants are herbivores (plant eaters). They use their trunk to gather food and water for drinking and bathing. They sometimes spend up to 16 hours a day eating.

Giraffes are the tallest animals on land. They can be found in grasslands or woodlands around the world. Their long necks help them to eat leaves from tall trees. Giraffes also have small horns on top of their heads. These horns help to protect their head in a fight.

Another interesting mammal is a mountain gorilla. Gorillas mostly live in forests of mountains. They have long hair which keeps them warm in cold mountains .They mostly eat plants and fruits. They sleep on grass, trees or build nests to sleep in. Mountain gorillas die when people cut down trees.

Alligators ➡ are meat eating reptiles. They spend most of their time in water. They can swim very fast, making it easier to catch their prey.

Most of the wild animals can be found in National game parks and zoos around the world.
