CALL FOR APPLICATION FOR SCHOLARSHIPS IN NURSING AND MIDWIFERY UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS.

East African Christian College (EACC) in collaboration with Ministry of Health in the framework of supporting 4x4 Strategy is excited to announce the funded scholarship opportunities (Tuition fees only) for Nursing and Midwifery programs. Prospective candidates are invited to apply for the following programs:

1. Bachelor of Science in General Nursing with Honours.
2. Bachelor of Science in Midwifery with Honours.

Application period: From Thursday 27th August, 2026 to Friday 11th September, 2026; 5pm.

Shortlisted candidates will be invited for the admission test at a date which will be communicated later.

Eligibility Criteria:

For Bachelor of Science in General Nursing with Honours (Four-Year Program) and Bachelor of Science in Midwifery with Honours (Four- Year Program) :

- a. Two principal passes with at least Grade C in Biology and Chemistry (for those who completed secondary school- A Level before the year 2024), and should not have failed (F) in Mathematics, Physics or Geography. Two principal passes with at least Grade E in Biology and Chemistry (for those who completed Secondary school - A Level from the year 2024 onwards).
- b. Completed general secondary education (A- Level) with one of the following principal subjects:
Physics-Chemistry- Biology, Mathematics- Chemistry- Biology, Biology- Chemistry- Geography.
- c. A2 Nurses with a Minimum of 70% and at least two years of work experience.

Admission Test and Selection process.

1. Candidates who meet minimum admission requirements for above programs will sit for an admission test.
2. Final selection of the scholarship beneficiaries will be based on the admission test score and available places for scholarships.
3. Successful applicants to benefit the scholarships will sign a contract with MOH to ensure their absorption into the health workforce after their graduation of which they will be required to serve for a minimum period of time.
